




Prairie House Inn is named for the style originated in Chicago around 1893 and continues to be one of the only indigenous American styles lasting two decades. The Inn is a pioneer home in more ways than one. Originally built around 1900, Prairie House Inn was the first house in Molalla to have running water and electricity. One of the first owners, William T. Eckerd, later converted the house into a pony express from the Main Street location. The Inn has maintained its history, having only four owners prior to being converted to a bed and breakfast inn by Nathan and Tootie Smith.

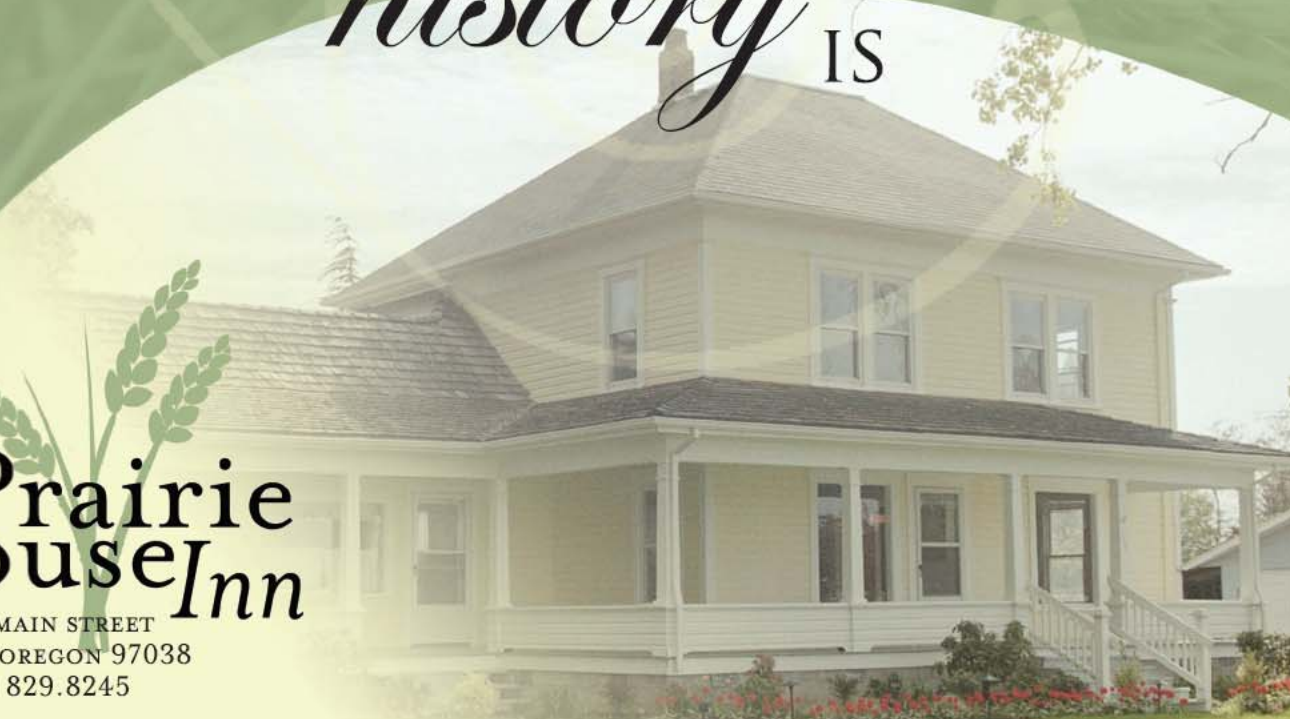

The airy, romantic *Cottage Room* is the signature room of the house, modeling the Prairie House style. It doubles as the bridal suite and a perfect weekend hideaway from stress.

Honoring the author of the Declaration of Independence, the *Jefferson Room* is rich with indigenous American furniture and décor.

The luxurious *Soleil Room* is finished in a country French design channeling the sophistication of the American Victorian era.

Enjoy a theme room from \$95 to \$125 per night, plus tax. Each room is designed to reflect a cultural aspect of Oregon's history. While the rooms have historical décor, each is equipped with DSL hook ups, air conditioning and queen-size beds.
